***Round Table** is an initiative by students for students and faculty. It is an HSM collaboration project between the student council and the Teaching Development Office. Teachers register themselves and their classes or teaching groups for the Round Table group discussions with the HSM Teaching Development Office. Trained student facilitators lead and facilitate the Round Table group discussions over a two-year period.*

They support students and faculty in developing a culture of dialogue and constructive feedback. They prepare confidential reports of the findings for faculty and students. Round Table group discussions are confidential and provide a safe space for dialogue.

In addition, Round Table enables...

...the development of a shared culture of constructive debate.

...the acquisition of communication skills relevant to the professional field.

...mutual growth among teachers and students.

...a more conscious approach to the real power imbalance between faculty and students.

Duration: approx. 90 minutes.
