#### Guideline



It is also an advantage if you personally inform the students in advance about the goals and the process of the questionnaire evaluation.

#### The teachers ...

- ... draw a personal conclusion from the dialogue with the students.
- ... derive measures from this and implement them independently.
- ... discuss the measures with the students.
- ... check the results and discuss them in the employee appraisal.


